

ANSTY PARISH COUNCIL

Draft Minutes Ansty Parish Council Monday 11th May 2015 held at St James' Church at 6.00pm

1. **Apologies for absence** from Julia Davies. Margaret Thompson will continue to be Chair of Ansty Parish Council.
2. **Present.** Chair Margaret Thompson, Cllr Juliette Foy, Cllr Morwenna Brewer, Cllr Ben Ridley and members of the public were Mr Morgan
3. **Declarations of Interest.** None
4. **Minutes of last meeting** on 9th March 2014 signed.
5. **Feedback on Planning** The McCarthy application for the stables has been passed with conditions. It did not go as far as we know to Committee.
6. **Police Report.** We had invited the police as we have not had a police representative at our meetings for some time. Issues had occurred which raised concerns in terms of break-ins to garages. Unfortunately no police were free to attend.
7. **Road Issues**
 - (i) **landslip.** Signs were put up originally by Wessex Water but it seems clear that BT Openreach were involved. Mr Morgan is concerned that if there is an accident who would be liable? Margaret Thompson thinks there should be a site meeting to discuss this ongoing matter.
 - (ii) **Coombe Lane** There was an issue with a vehicle blocking Blind Lane due a Sat Nav problem which should have sent the driver to an address in Wardour. Margaret Thompson will send a letter to the council regarding the landslide and lorry congestion on Coombe lane.
8. **Transparency Code.** All Parish Councils are now required to arrange for creation of a publically accessible website to show all details of the PC eg financial information, councillor responsibility regarding floods, ditches footpaths verges etc .members of any subcommittees etc, Mr Morgan suggested that his daughter might be able to help in building a website. The PC awaits information from WALC about grants to make this possible. Otherwise we may have to use local expertise to avoid raising the precept.
9. **Flytipping** This has occurred on the Arundel estate. One of the Cllrs will investigate.

10. **Village Insurance Information.** Ansty Parish Council pays for this from a WALC source which all PCs can access. It gives good rates. Any activity which is the responsibility of the council can be covered if agreed and the appropriate form and details supplied.
11. **Best Kept Village.** Ansty has entered and as they did so before end of April will receive 10 bags of compost.
