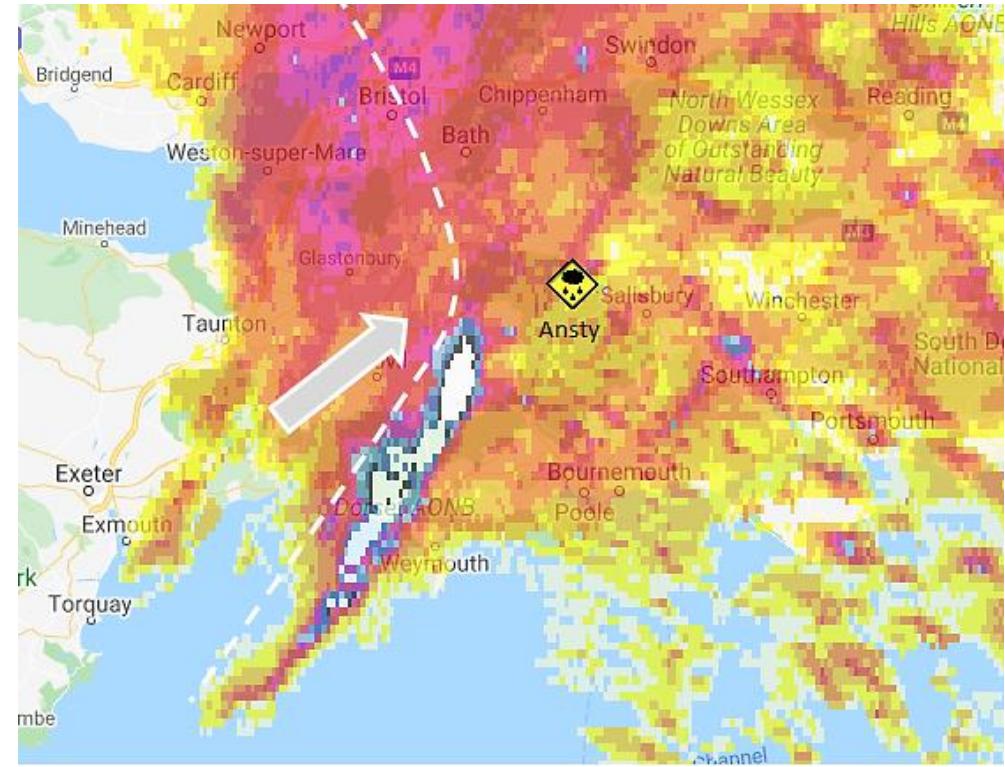
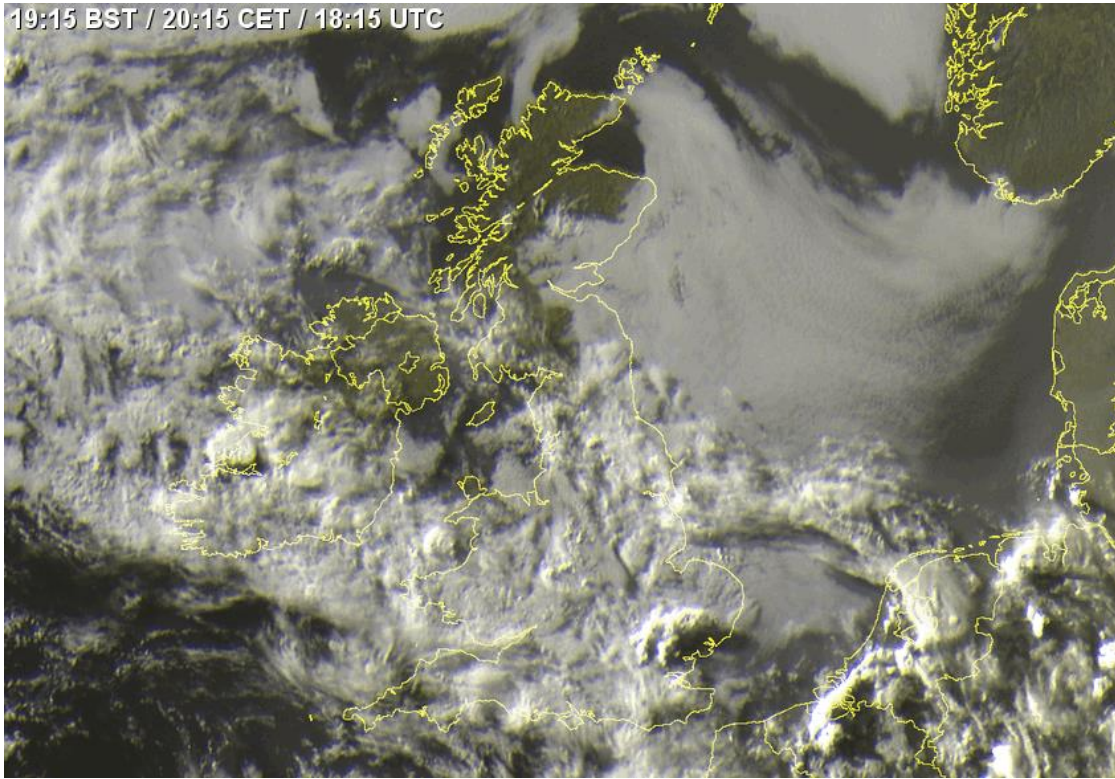
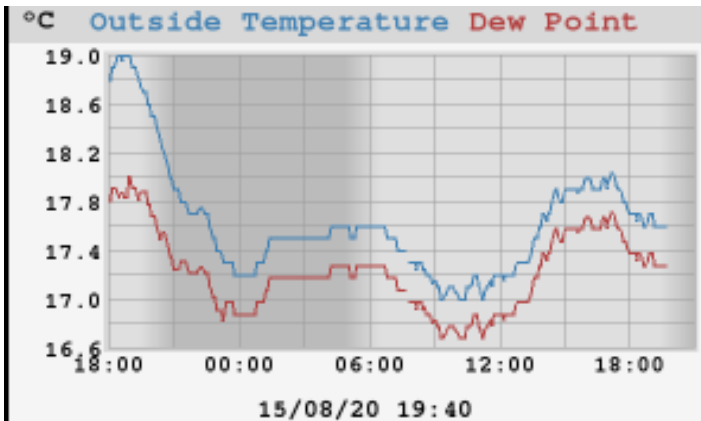

AUGUST WEATHER IN ANSTY 2020

August was very dry and hot for the first 2 weeks; but then the rains came...



Left-

A pall of cloud over England on 15th August. The day was damp with rain falling around the middle of the day.

The most notable feature was how constant the temperature remained day and night: from 17.8 C from 9pm the night before to 17.8 C 24 hours later – varying by less than 1 C degree!

Right-

Another wet day on the 27th of August. The cold front bringing up the rear of the rain area brought torrential rain accompanied with squally winds and thunder and lightning in the late afternoon.

An inch of rain fell in less than an hour. By tea time it was all over as indicated by the rainbow over Ansty. But it did leave lots of standing water!
