Annual Weather Statistics for Ansty Parish 2021

Temperatures

The yearly average temperature for this year was 10.6 C – only 0.6 C above the long-term average – so not a record-breaking warm year thank goodness. Bear in mind that it has been a very long time since we saw the mean annual temperature actually dip below the long-term average! January was quite cold but the winter was generally relatively mild with a couple of days of lying snow (just) but we had an unusually cold April largely down to clear skies and many sharp frosts – into May in fact. The lowest temperature recorded was -6.1 C on the 11th January. There were 67 night-time frosts – well above the long-term average of 50. The summer was nothing to write home about either – no real heatwaves and subdued temperatures throughout. The highest temperature recorded was 31.5 C on the 21st July – it turned out to be a one day heatwave. It will be interesting to see what the annual average global temperatures turn out to be. One's perception is that it is likely to be in another 'warm' category ...

Precipitation

The annual rainfall total for this year was 'bang on' average when looking at the long-term figures. What is very noticeable these days is how that rainfall is delivered and these days we perceive that our rain is more often arriving in the form of heavy dense downpours: not so much thundery – just heavy like water drops emanating from a watering can rose! Here in Wiltshire, we also seem to get more grey days with cloud and drizzle falling for days at a time - the kind of weather that Devon, Cornwall, and west Wales have been used to for longer: the maritime conditions are penetrating further east. This ties in with the fact that the annual relative humidity figures this year was 87% - very humid indeed and these figures have been slowly rising year on year for the last 2 or 3 decades. Having said that we did get 182 days of bright sunshine and 149 days of precipitation this year. October was the wettest month by far and 3 inches of rain fell in a 36-hour period causing local floods.

Wind Speed and Direction

As our weather station is in a sheltered valley our winds do not reflect the general pattern of wind direction over our parish, so this year we have used the Wind Direction as recorded by the professional weather station at Boscombe Down. We have included our local wind speeds but of course, down in the Coombe it is sheltered, and we reckon that you can easily double the wind speed for our more open areas and on top of the hills! This year we twice recorded wind gusts of over 30 mph (in May and November) and these values would easily translate to 60+ mph in our more exposed areas. Indeed, on both occasions some branches and small trees did come down.

All in all – a more 'average year' than what we have been used to over the last decade or two.
